## **Proposed Role Description: Policy and Advocacy Co-ordinator**

The Policy and Advocacy Co-ordinator is (initially) a co-opted member of the AARE Executive responsible for working closely with the President and the Communications Co-ordinator to oversee the Association's policy and advocacy activities.

In the first two years, the role will involve:

- 1. Developing an advocacy strategy for the Association, with the aim of establishing enhanced links between AARE and education policymakers at a national level.
- 2. Developing processes and procedures to support AARE to respond to education policy announcements and other relevant developments in a swift and agile fashion.
- 3. Working with the Blog Editor to ensure the smooth running of EduResearch Matters, and provide a conduit between the Blog Editor and the AARE Executive.
- 4. Providing a link between MCERA and AARE, with the aim of enhancing the ability of the Association and its members to work effectively with the mainstream media.
- 5. Exploring other pathways by which AARE members might collectively and individually impact education policy in Australia.

It is envisaged that an appointment would be made by co-option for an initial period of two to three years, with the possibility of the position being made an ongoing Executive role via a constitutional change at the conclusion of the initial period.
